- 1. ISA meeting: (questions, future teachers appreciation program)
 - -Attended meeting with new director and placement coordinator
 - -Discussed registration issue for students in second stage (difficulty registering for professional seminar and placement simultaneously, issue was solved)
 - -Future Teachers' Appreciation Program: new MISE initiative that pays about \$4,000 to students on their final field experience
 - -Unsure if it will continue into the next year, but will happen for this year
 - -To receive award, submit an application, money received in 2 separate payments
 - -Poor communication between government and McGill, information is online via the government
 - -Eligibility: MUST BE COMPLETELY UNPAID, do not have to qualify for work-study to participate
 - -Gave more information about the process of finding placements for students (ie. cannot communicate with teachers directly)
 - -If you know a specific teacher with at least 5 years of \

- experience, recommended that you contact them and have them speak to their principal
- -Also, write this in your placement details when filling out your placement form
- -Encourages ALL students to fill out this box, regardless of whether you have communicated with them
